Team Quota Size	Maximum 3 divers per each individual event, and 2 pairs of divers per synchronised event.
Competition Events	<p><b>Men:</b> 1m Springboard, 3m Springboard, 10m Platform, Synchronised 3m Springboard, Synchronised 10m Platform</p> <p><b>Women:</b> 1m Springboard, 3m Springboard, 10m Platform, Synchronised 3m Springboard, Synchronised 10m Platform</p> <p><b>*Mixed Synchronised 3m Springboard, *Mixed Synchronised 10m Platform</b></p> <p><i>*Divers in mixed synchronised events must come from athletes entered in other diving events.</i></p>
Eligibility	<p>To be considered for nomination to SNOC, a diver must meet all of the following eligibility criteria and maintain through the Games:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Be a Singapore Citizen, and at least 14 years old and above as of 31 Dec 2022.</li> </ol>

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2. Signed the Athlete Agreement.</li> <li>3a. Attained a qualifying score equivalent to 6<sup>th</sup> place score of the last Commonwealth Games (i.e. Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games) in which the event was last held, in any one of the approved meets (listed above – <i>Selection Events</i>), or have beaten the 6<sup>th</sup> placed diver/synchronised pair of the last Commonwealth Games in which the event was last held, in any one of the approved meets.</li> <li>3b. Where 4 or more individual divers, or 3 or more synchronised pairs have met the qualifying criteria in an event during the qualifying period, the top 3 individual divers or top 2 synchronised pair, will be nominated to SNOC.</li> <li>3c. The remaining quota spots, after the nomination deadline, may be filled by individual divers or synchronised pairs based on scores from the Selection Events by SSA Appeal to SNOC.</li> <li>4. Continues to train regularly for peak diving performance and be fit for competitions for 6 months leading up to the Games.</li> <li>5. Not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athlete’s body tissue or fluids, would be constituted as doping, or used any prohibited method or committed any other doping offence as defined in ADS’s, WADA or FINA’s Anti-Doping By law.</li> <li>6. In addition to the above selection criteria, the following qualities of the divers will be taken into consideration: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Attitude and behaviour;</li> <li>b. Current skill level and fitness;</li> <li>c. Level of commitment and training attendance;</li> <li>d. Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with teammates and officials</li> </ol> </li> </ol>
Team Commitments	<p>All divers must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Comply with the provisions of the SSA and SNOC Athlete Agreement at all times.</li> <li>2. Conform to SSA requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required.</li> <li>3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by SSA.</li> <li>4. Not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or SSA into public disrepute.</li> </ol>
Appeal Process	<p>Any diver who is aggrieved with his/her non-selection may undertake an appeal as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The diver must contact the Vice President (Diving) within 48 hours from the official announcement of the selection results and inform of his/her intent to appeal.</li> <li>2. The Vice President may ask the diver to outline the basis of his/her appeal and will seek a report from the National Head Coach, within 24 hours of receiving written notification from the diver.</li> </ol>

	<p>3. If the appeal committee is of the opinion that the selection process was not adhered to and the appeal is justified, the committee can overturn the decision of the selection committee. The appeals committee decision is final.</p> <p>Note : - <i>Protests against the scores given by the judges during the competition or trials conducted, as part of the appeal, shall not be considered.</i></p>
Notes	<p>The Singapore National Olympic Council (SNOC) is the body which sets the qualifying standards for all sports.
