1.0 COMPETITION INFORMATION

Competition: Liberty Insurance 52nd SNAG Juniors Sprints

Juniors Age Group – 8 to 12 years under (for swimmers born between 2010 to 2014)

Venue: OCBC Aquatic Centre

Dates: 12th to 14th March 2022 (Saturday to Monday)

2.0 GENERAL INFORMATION

2.1 The Championships shall be conducted under the Rules and By-laws of FINA as prescribed in the Handbook of FINA (2017). One-start rule applies. The list of approved swimsuits can be viewed at <http://fina.org/content/fina-approved-swimwear>

2.2 The **52nd SNAG Juniors Sprints** are open only to the following:

a. Swimmers who are existing members of SSA Affiliates (thereafter known as Affiliates).

2.3 All entries must be submitted through SSA Affiliates.

2.4 Definition of Swimmers:

a. Local Swimmers- All Affiliated Members with Singapore Citizenship

b. Foreign Swimmers- All Non-Singaporean Affiliated Members

3.0 AGE GROUPS

3.1 A swimmer may only compete in the stipulated age group in which he/she falls under.

3.2 Age groups are computed as of follows:

b. Juniors

8 to 12 years under (for swimmers born between 2010 to 2014)

4.0 ENTRY REGULATIONS

There is no entry qualifying time to participate at the 52nd SNAG Juniors 2022. However, the participating swimmers must achieve a minimum time standard at this meet. An administrative fee of **S\$30.00** per event will be imposed if a swimmer returns time slower than the minimum time standard

Each swimmer will be allowed a maximum of 4 individual events at this SNAG

- 4.1 **Swimmers Registration Fee** (For all swimmers)
2022 Annual Registration Fee is **S\$30.00 (inclusive of 7% GST)** per swimmer.
- 4.2 **Entry Fee**
- a. Individual Event - **S\$10.00 (inclusive of 7% GST)** per event
- 4.3 Withdrawals of entered events can be done at no charge only at the Team Leaders Meeting but entries fees will not be refunded.

5.0 COMPETITION EVENTS

Juniors Programme:

Events listed below will be for both Boys and Girls:

- a. Freestyle: 50m, 100m
- b. Backstroke: 50m, 100m
- c. Breaststroke: 50m, 100m
- d. Butterfly: 50m, 100m
- e. *Individual Medley: 200m

*200m IM for swimmers aged 10 to 12 years only

The Juniors Program will be run in a timed finals format in 10 Lanes Pool setup from fastest to slowest

Competitors (regardless of age) shall be placed in graduated time order, fastest to slowest in 10-lane pool.

6.0 WITHDRAWALS

- 6.1 An administrative fee of **S\$30.00** shall be imposed on each withdrawal from entered event after the release of the start list till 60 mins before the start of each session.
- 6.2 Withdrawals within sixty (60) minutes of the start of each session (Heats or Finals) or without notification to the Control Room Supervisor shall be deemed Did Not Show or Did Not Start (DNS). A penalty of **S\$100.00** shall be imposed on all DNS.
- 6.3 Withdrawals for finals **including** the Reserve Swimmers of each event must be presented to the Control Room Supervisor **within 30 minutes of the posting of the Overall Heats result** to avoid the administrative fee.
- 6.4 The administrative fee and penalty will be waived if the swimmer produces a valid medical certificate for the relevant day of the race. However, the swimmer will not be permitted to participate in any further races for the day.

7.0 PROTESTS

- 7.1 Protests are possible:
 - a. if the rules and regulations for the conduct of the competition are not observed,
 - b. if other conditions endanger the competitions and/or competitors, or
 - c. against decisions of the referee; however, no protest shall be allowed against decisions of fact.
- 7.2 All protests shall be considered by the Meet Referee.
- 7.3 If conditions causing a potential protest are noted prior to the competition, a protest must be lodged before the signal to start the race is given.
- 7.4 Protests must be submitted in accordance with the following:
 - a. In writing, with the supporting facts
 - b. With a deposit of **S\$100.00** enclosed
 - c. Submitted to the Meet Referee by Affiliate Team Leader. No proxies will be entertained
 - d. Submitted within thirty (30) minutes following the conclusion of the respective event

- 7.5 If the Meet Referee rejects the protest, he/she must state the reasons for his decision. The Team Leader may then appeal the rejection to the Jury of Appeal, whose decision shall be final.
- 7.6 If the protest is not upheld, the deposit shall be forfeited to the Organising Committee of the Championships. If the protest is upheld, the deposit shall be returned.

12.0 HEALTH DECLARATIONS

- 12.1 All personnel are to stay home and should not return to participate, if they are / have:
- on Medical Leave
 - ART+, PCR+ and tested positive of COVID-19
 - with respiratory symptoms (cough, sore throat, fever or shortness of breath), even if mild.
 - with a temperature above 38 degrees Celsius are considered as having a fever.
 - Serving SHN or Quarantine Order
- 12.2 For individuals on who are on Health Risk Notice (HRN), they will be allowed to enter the venue subjected to daily ART Test negative (applicable to Day 1 – 5 from notification).
The photos of ART Test negative to be sent to organisers via the clubs
- 12.3 All participating swimmers are reminded to void strenuous activities, like swimming, for 2 weeks post vaccination jab
